This study is adapted from "Celebrate Recovery"; it focuses on the Beatitudes & condenses the study into eight weeks.

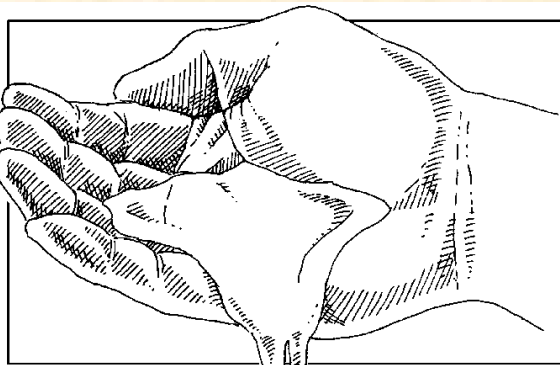
